ORDINANCE NO. 5

Section 1

And be it further Ordained, that no person or persons shall be permitted or allowed to ride upon hand sleds, bicycles or or any other conveyance on the sidewalks, or to draw, push or drive any cart or carts on any of the side walks within the limits of this Borough under penalty of a sum not less than fifty cents for the first offence, or exceeding five dollars for each subsequent offence. And it shall the duty of the C Constable, and it is enjoined upon them to see that this Ordinance be enforced by arresting the offender and taking him or them before the Burgess or Justice of the Peace of the County for trial, as often as they know of any infraction of this ordinance.
